

Gather the necessary tools as shown below to complete the installation of this faucet. Some may not be needed depending on the model of faucet you are installing.





# **Parts Diagram**




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# **Faucet Installation**



1. Position the faucet, deck plate 16 and putty plate 20 on countertop as shown.


## **Faucet Installation**



2.Put the washer 21 and plastic locknut 22 to tailpiece of faucet and tighten the plastic locknut by hand.

## Configuration



Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8" O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8" Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (½")



## Warning:

The supply valves and supply lines are not included, please purchase them at a plumbing supply store.



### Important:

Remove the aerator and let both hot and cold water run for one minute to clear any line trash. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system. Re-assemble aerator.

Test system for leaks.
